

**Report of the Glenn D. Loucks Track and Field Games
May 10, 11, & 12, 2012
Held at White Plains High School**

The Glenn D. Loucks Track and Field Games were held at White Plains High School on May 10-12, 2011. This was the 45th anniversary of the games and, again, they were a huge success thanks largely to the assistance provided by the Rotary Club of White Plains and its members. More than 300 teams totaling almost 3,000 athletes were present at this year's event, making it the largest on-site high school invitational track meet in the country.
